Blue Line North to Close June to September 2019



Metro Blue Line will be out of service from 7th St/Metro Center to Compton Station, June 1 through late September 2019. Major improvements are underway for Metro's oldest light rail line. Starting Saturday, June 1, 2019, the Blue Line will be out of service between the 7th St/Metro Center and Compton Station, including the Blue Line Willowbrook/Rosa Parks Station, through late September 2019. The improvements will also require two stations on the Expo Line to be out of service (Pico Station and 7th St/Metro Center) from June 22 to late August 2019. Bus shuttles will replace rail service.
